The Prevention Unit will be hosting the Spring 2026 cycle of SFP in Chico. This cycle will start January 26th and conclude May 4th. There will be (13) Monday evening sessions that begin at 5:30 PM and end by 8:00 PM. In addition, there will be (1) Saturday session (Family Challenge Day).

The Strengthening Families
Program (SFP) is an evidencebased family skills training program
that is recognized both nationally
and internationally. Each week will
include a family dinner, separate
class trainings for parents and
youth ages 7-11 and 12-17 years of
age, followed by a joint family
practice session to close out the
evening. SFP is intended to serve
the entire family which includes
childcare for children ages 6 and
under.
